Ordinance 50.03

It shall be the responsibility of any person referred to in § 50.02 to cut and place any brush neatly between the sidewalk and the street, with nothing extending over the road or sidewalk, with the cut end facing the road. Brush may be placed in the right-of-way no earlier than the Friday preceding pickup. Brush may not exceed five inches in diameter or eight feet in length. There shall be no garden waste, leaves, lumber, roots, concrete, stones, or poison ivy mixed with the brush. Thorny bushes and vines must be cut into four-foot lengths and tied in small bundles with string (no rope, twine, or wire).

Tip of the Month: Sunday, March 14th is the start of DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME. Don't forget to change your clocks.

The Village Office and the DPW will be closed on April 2, 2021 in observance of Good Friday. We hope everyone has a great Easter weekend!

Pick up will be scheduled for these days but due to unforeseen circumstances the pick-up may happen at any time during that week.

Rules to leaf pick up can be found at www.villageofwebberville.com and type leaf pick up in the search engine.

- 1. Rake leaves to the edge of the street, not in the street. If we cannot reach them with the vacuum hose we will not be able to pick them up.
- 2. Do not make leaf piles wider than (4') four feet wide or we cannot reach them all.
- 3. Do not rake leaves around posts, signs, mailboxes or cars keep them at least (4') four feet away from all objects.
- 4. Do not pile them at intersections where we will have to block traffic to pick them up.
- 5. Do not mix trash, sticks, rocks or other debris with leaves as it will cause damage to the leaf vacuum and/or injury.
- 6. Do not pile brush and leaves together we cannot sort it for you.
- 7. Do not put leaves in bags we do not pick up bags.

PLEASE remember to keep your sidewalks clear - the Village DPW ONLY does the Downtown sidewalks. Ordinance 92.15 Snow Removal Required. The occupant of any premises in the village, which includes any house, store, building, or lot, upon which there is, located a public sidewalk, shall remove or cause to be removed from the sidewalk ice and snow subject to the following requirements.

- (A) All snow and ice shall be removed within 24 hours after it has ceased if the accumulation is less than four inches.
- (B) All snow and ice shall be removed within 48 hours if the accumulation is more than four inches.

PLEASE make sure to not park or allow patrons or tenants to park on the main roads when it snows – it makes it difficult for the DPW to clear them prior to business hours. No Parking on streets between 3 a.m. and 6 a.m.

• If you have delinquent utility bills prior to December 31, 2020 or any delinquent permits, invoices or code enforcement balances, they will be placed on the 2021 tax bill as of June 2021. Village 2021 tax bills will be out July 1.
