REMINDER: When the snow begins the Village of Webberville has an ordinance to keep the sidewalks clear. If the snow is 4 inches or less it has to be cleared within 24 hours, if it is more than 4 inches it has to be cleared within 48 hours. If the Village DPW has to clear your sidewalk you will be charged an ordinance fine and fees. Let's keep our sidewalks clear and safe for easy passage of pedestrians. THANK YOU!!

Please keep vehicles off of the streets and out of the public parking areas during the winter months so that the DPW can remove snow safely and efficiently.

Please do not blow your leaves out into the road; this can be very dangerous. Thank you!
