**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF WEBBERVILLE TO ENTER
INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION TO IMPLEMENT THE SURFACE TRANSPORTATION
PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, The Michigan Department of Transportation hereinafter referred to as MDOT; has submitted contract number 13 – 5476 to the Village of Webberville, a Michigan municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as the VILLAGE; for the purpose of fixing the rights and obligations of the parties agreeing to the following improvements; hereinafter referred to as the PROJECT, in the VILLAGE and estimated in detail on EXHIBIT “I”, dated August 15, 2013, attached hereto and made a part hereof:

PART A – FEDERAL PARTICIPATION

Hot mix asphalt cold milling and resurfacing work along East Grand River Avenue from Elm Road to Gramer Road; including intermediate curb and gutter, sidewalk ramp, sign, and pavement marking work; and all together with necessary related work.

PART B – NO FEDERAL PARTICIPATION

Paving parking area work along East Grand River Avenue from Elm Road to Gramer Road; and all together with necessary related work.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Federal law, monies have been provided for the performance of certain improvements on public roads; and

WHEREAS, the reference “FHWA” in PART I and PART II refers to the United States Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration; and

WHEREAS, the PROJECT, or portions of the PROJECT, at the request of the VILLAGE, is being programmed with the FHWA, for implementation with the use of Federal Funds under the following Federal program(s) or funding:

SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE has assigned Brad Hitchcock, Sr. , President of the VILLAGE, and Michael Killackey, Department of Public Works, as the authorized signers for the contract between MDOT and the VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have reached an understanding with each other regarding the performance of the PROJECT work and desire to set forth this understanding in the form of a written contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual undertaking of the parties and in conformity with applicable law the Village will enter into the contract prepared by MDOT and submitted on September 24, 2013.


