2022 Village Tax bills have gone out July 1<sup>st</sup>. If you have a mortgage company and you receive a blue bill in the mail you need to contact your mortgage company. This means that they did not request a copy of the bill from our office. If you receive a white bill this means a mortgage company requested a copy of your 2022 Village tax bill. If you have had unpaid utility bills and a portion of the unpaid bills were prior to December 31, 2021, you may want to check your tax bill for a delinquent utility bill to tax assessment. Taxes are due September 14<sup>th</sup>. The village does not accept post mark. After September 14<sup>th</sup>, your unpaid bills go to the Ingham County Treasurer and will incur penalty and interest. Please do not pay your taxes with your water bill; if possible, please make separate payments for each of them.

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The summer taxes through Leroy township will be coming out in July as well. Through the township you have summer taxes in July, and winter taxes in December. These taxes pay the school tax, County (including your drain assessment) and township taxes. The July Leroy Township tax bill is yellow and the December winter bill is pink. July bills for the township are also due on September 14<sup>th</sup>. These taxes have to be paid at the Township so please do not pay your Village and Township taxes in the same check it could cause one of them to be delinquent. Leroy Township is also where the Assessor is for both of the taxes. You can reach the Township by calling 517-521-3729.



## Joke of the Month:



### § 50.07 RECREATIONAL BURNING.

(A) It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership, lessee, or occupant to burn any garbage, including treated wood or other waste material, within the village. Material that is acceptable to burn in a recreational fire shall be limited to clean, clear, unpainted, unfinished, and untreated wood and wood products excluding particle board and similar products, split firewood, tree limbs, and charcoal. No accelerant such as gasoline and kerosene may be used except charcoal lighter fluid. (B) Recreational fires shall be permitted. A recreational fire shall be an outdoor fire and located in a fire pit, outdoor grill, and/or container commercially constructed for use as a fire pit and/or burner that is designed to adequately contain ashes and cinders. The fire shall be limited to a container no larger than 36 inches in diameter, and must be done no closer than ten feet to property lines or 15 feet from any building or structure. Burning should be confined to the rear yard unless conditions exist that it is not possible. No burning may be conducted in the front yard. Flames may not exceed 18 inches in height. (C) Any recreational fire shall be constantly attended by a person at least 16 years of age, who is fully physically and mentally capable of extinguishing the fire.
